Why choose to feed Cattle Weaner Pellets?

Maximizing weight gain and healthy development is the purpose of feeding cattle weaner pellets (6mm). Furneys cattle weaner pellets have an industry wide acceptance with graziers feeding heifers as a supplement to pasture in lick feeders, or commonly used in a program taking weaner steers through to the supermarket trade, successful operators feed daily in accordance with pasture analysis. As pasture energy decreases weaner pellet supplementation replaces the energy and protein deficiencies.

Feeding guide for Cattle Weaner Pellets

Introduce the pellet slowly and build up to 1% of body weight plus 2% of good quality hay in the first week. Over the next two week period increase pellets until feeding approx 2.2% of body weight and 0.8% good quality hay.

Supplementary Feeding

After accessing MJ ME/KG Dry Matter of your pasture lick feeders can be adjusted to increase or decrease availability. If not feed daily into troughs and control intake.

This product is suitable for Beef cattle only. The above feeding rates are a guide only. Variances due to pasture quality, climate, workload and age of cattle will give different results. Please use the feeding table as a guide only and ensure feeding guide is introduced gradually, as unobserved diet changes can be detrimental to the final results and/or the animals health.
