### ***Feeding guide for Goat Fattener Pellets***

*Introduce the pellet slowly and build up to 1% of body weight plus 2% of good quality hay in the first week. Over the next two week period increase pellets until feeding approx 2.2% of body weight and 0.8% good quality hay.*

*Clean freshwater is essential.*

*Note: Best results are achieved with daily feeding*

This product is suitable for goats only. The above feeding rates are a guide only. Variances due to pasture quality, climate, workload and age of goats will give different results. Please use the feeding table as a guide only and ensure feeding guide is introduced gradually, as unobserved diet changes can be detrimental to the final results and/or the animals health.
