Why choose to feed Goat Nuts?

Goat nuts are large pellets made so goats can pick up off the ground leaving no waste. The ration has been formulated to maintain stock at their present condition at the recommended consumption rate. The pellet does contain a rumen buffer for acidosis protection. Whole cereal grains are ground and blended with vitamins A, D & E, minerals lime, salt and bentonite clay, along with 1% urea is added to stimulate the micro organisms in the stomach.

Daily feeding guide for Goat Nuts

The following is a daily suggested feeding ration based on a 30kg dry goat. Introduce slowly and build up to full ration over a two week period to avoid any occurrence of grain poisoning if animals haven't been feed grain based feed before.

Day 1-5 50gm **Day 6-10** 100g
Day 11-15 300gm **Day 15+** 600gm

Best results achieved with daily feeding.

Eskalin can be added with an S4 Vet script.

This product does not contain restricted animal material.

This product is suitable for goats only. The above feeding rates are a guide only. Variances due to pasture quality, climate, workload and age of goats will give different results. Please use the feeding table as a guide only and ensure feeding guide is introduced gradually, as unobserved diet changes can be detrimental to the final results and/or the animals health.
